

WHAT IS STARFISH FOR SOFIA?

Starfish for Sofia is a Non-Profit company founded by Sofia's mommy Claire. Sofia died by drowning on 20 December 2014. She was only 2 years old. Sofia's mommy Claire now runs this fundraising organisation to ensure that children, specifically between the ages of 6 months and 3 years and particularly from underprivileged families, can attend swimming classes. These classes teach children to float on their backs with their arms and legs outstretched (in the shape of a starfish) when they fall into a body of water, allowing them to remain calm until somebody can come and rescue them. Even if these children do not go on to attend further swimming classes and do not learn to swim properly, this essential survival technique will remain with them their whole lives and enable us to prevent drowning.
